#### OAuth 1.0 Protocol published in April 2010

#### **OAuth**

From Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia

**OAuth** is an open standard for authorization. OAuth provides client applications a 'secure delegated access' to server resources on behalf of a resource owner. It specifies a process for resource owners to authorize third-party access to their server resources without sharing their credentials.



Request token - make signed GET request to the request token URL. (sign request using consumer key and secret)


You get back parameterized authorization url with oauth\_token parsed into it e.g. https://api.twitter.com/oauth/authorize?

Go to url get users consent to allow app access to your account.

Redirects to app call back url with oauth\_token and oauth\_verifier.

The oauth\_verifier is the access token for the user.

Paste into the code the oauth\_verifier

### A bit of tweet-detail




### Account ages of Mark's followers






### Gender of Mark's followers
